Māori forestry plantation area is 2.9% of the national planted area -36% of pre 1990 forests.750,000 ha of forest planted on Māori land.	Māori will control ALL NZ exotic forests if Māori plant a further 1 million ha. On land already owned by Maori	Control 40 -50 million m3 of wood. Māori become the "major" player in global market for NZ timber exports.
Working in with SCION – new business opportunities for Māori in forestry. Eco tours	Control solid wood + Fiber to Bio fuel plants.	Māori would be major player in NZ Bio Fuel industry or owner of the industry?
Developing Bio Fuel Business	Māori will be a major player in Geo Thermal	Supply up to 60% of NZ liquid fuel use by 2035.
Developing new industries – bio char, activated carbon, carbon black	Developing new Bio Products Industry. Pharmaceuticals.	Would need 24 plants size of current pulp mills. Equates to 20 – 30,000 new Full time jobs over next 20 years.
